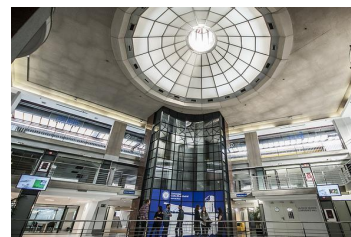

Some general rules must be taken into account when choosing your courses:

- Most courses are ONLY OFFERED in one Semester
- Minimum: 6 ECTS for Semester / Maximum: 30 ECTS for Semester
- Erasmus+ students can only select courses from the School that they have been admitted to.
- Non European students can select any of the courses from ALL the Schools

We recommend partner institutions to emphasize course flexibility to their students and bring some additional courses approved in case their first options are not always available.
