

2nd ZJU Scholars Summer Research Program Zhejiang University

18 June -- 13 August, 2019, Hangzhou, China

Program Overview

In the summer of 2019, Zhejiang University will hold the **2nd ZJU Scholars Summer Research Program** for talented students from selected partner universities with the aim of promoting existing academic ties among its strategic partners and providing cutting-edge research experience to the young generation of future leaders and experts worldwide.

This year, for each selected partner institution, ZJU will provide up to 2 students with a scholarship to participate in a research project of their choice at ZJU for 8 weeks from June 18th to Aug. 13th, 2019.

The scholarship includes:

- √ Waived application fee and program tuition fee
- √ Free on-campus accommodation from June 17th to Aug. 14th, 2019 (double room)
- √ A living allowance of 2800 RMB (approximately 400 USD) per person

Successful applicants will participate in a research project under the guidance of a renowned ZJU professor and work closely with post docs, postgraduate and senior undergraduate students from the same research team. During the 8-week program, participants will join an elite cohort of domestic students in a dynamic, inspiring environment and become an integral part of the innovative and diversified ZJU community ever since!

Eligibility

- √ Outstanding full-time undergraduate students between their third and fourth years, masters or PhD students from the selected partner universities
- √ Good English proficiency (no English language certificate is required)
- \checkmark Relevant academic background (please see the special requirements of each lab in the excel file)
- √ Non-Chinese nationality
- √ Applicants must nominated by the International Office of their home university
- √ Applicants must receive approval for the research program from a ZJU advising professor before submitting applications to the International Office of ZJU

Program costs

Students will have to bear their own international airfare, local transportation, insurance, visa application fee as well as other personal expenses in Hangzhou.

Application process

- √ December 20th, 2018: Announcement of the program application
- √ December 20th, 2018 to March 10th, 2019: <u>Students need to contact ZJU professors</u> by themselves and get the scanned copy of the written approval from a ZJU professor before the deadline of application. Please indicate "ZJU Scholars" in the subject of your email to ZJU professors. Students are also recommended to e-mail their CV, a recommendation letter from their home university supervisor, research proposal and latest transcripts to ZJU professors of their choice.
- √ March 10th, 2019: Deadline for nomination and submission of application (please e-mail the nomination sheet together with the application documents to the international coordinator of ZJU).
- √ April 20th, 2019: Admission Announcement
- √ By June 17, 2019: Admitted students should have applied for and obtained their visa to China and purchased their international insurance as well.
