Terms and Conditions for Summer Session 2023

Program Dates: June 24 – August 20, 2023

All dates and fees are subject to change at the discretion of the University.

A. Summer Session Program Timeline

November 15 (Mon) Summer Session application open date.*

*The IHP application link will be shared once the nomination list is submitted.

February (TBD) 2023 Courses are posted on the Summer Session website.

March 1 (Wed) Deadline to submit student nomination list to Patricia Hall, pghall@stanford.edu

March 8 (Wed) Application completion date.*

***All IHP students must have their application submitted by this date in order to be on track for course enrollment and I-20 processing.**

April 5 (Wed) Acceptance completion date.*

*Students must complete all acceptance forms via their status page. Deadline based on partners' desire to prioritize course enrollment by Axess open date.

April 10 (Mon) Axess opens for course enrollment.

May 15 (Mon) Summer Quarter Cardinal Care (Health Insurance) Waiver Deadline.

June 1 (Thur) Deadline to submit Health Requirements to Vaden Health Center portal.

June 24 (Sat) Welcome event and mandatory check-in.

June 26 (Mon) First day of quarter; instruction begins.

June 26 (Mon, 5:00 p.m.) Preliminary Study List deadline.

June 26 (Mon, 5:00 p.m.) Deadline to withdraw from the program for a full refund.

July 4 (Tue) Independence Day (holiday, no classes).

July 7 (Fri, 5:00 p.m.) Final Study List deadline. Final day to add or drop a class. Last day for tuition reassessment for dropped courses or units. Students may withdraw from a course until the Course Withdrawal deadline and a 'W' notation will appear on the transcript.

July 28 (Fri, 5 p.m.) Term withdrawal deadline; last day to submit Annulment of Summer Registration form to withdraw from the University with a partial refund.

Aug 4 (Fri, 5:00 p.m.) Change of grading basis deadline.*

*IHP students must take courses for a letter grade, wherever possible.

Aug 4 (Fri, 5:00 p.m.) Course withdrawal deadline. Final day to drop a course with a “W” notation on the transcript. After this deadline, students will receive a grade.

August 17 (Thu) Last day of classes.

August 17 (Thu) Last opportunity to arrange Incomplete in a course, at last class.

August 18-19 (Fri-Sat) End-Quarter examinations.

August 29 (Tue, 11:59 p.m.) Grades due.
