New: Blended (Short-Term) Internships are introduced with the new Erasmus+ Program. Students can now participate in the program with 5-30 Days of Physical mobility, accompanied by a virtual component. More information can be found on our [website](#).

New and mandatory: All students applying to this program must enter their application through [TurnaPortal](#) as well. A guideline for the application system can be found on our [website](#). The applications which are not entered into the portal by the deadline will not be considered.

Students who cannot submit their application on KUAPP will be asked to fill out the [Erasmus+ Internship Manual Application Form](#) by the application deadline. Their applications will be entered into the system manually. However, these students will still have to complete their application on [TurnaPortal](#) by the deadline.

Internship Quota & Grant Allocation

The estimated quota for the Erasmus+ Internship Second Round for the 2023-24 academic year will be **10 students**, based on the budget given within the Erasmus+ 2023 project. If there are more applications, students not placed in the first 10 will be substituted for grant allocation.

In case there is an additional grant for students, OIP will be announcing it along with the announcement of the results.

Duration of the physical activity	Amount
Up to the 14th day of activity	79 EUR per day
15th to the 30th day of activity	56 EUR per day

Please note that the Erasmus+ Grant for all participants is not guaranteed. Students will be informed about their eligibility and the duration of their grant once the application results are announced. Maximum funding for the Erasmus+ Internship program will be 2 months.
